infinimax\_wheel\_driver.zip Saudi Arabia arrests top Al Jazeera editor in an apparent bid to stop reporting on the kingdom's internal dissent. Saudi Arabia has arrested one of the country's top editors at Al Jazeera, and he is now being investigated for alleged sedition, according to the channel and local media reports. Al Jazeera said on Saturday that Mahmoud al-Kashif was detained on November 9. Al-Kashif's arrest is an apparent attempt to silence him and cut off his access to key sources, the

channel said. “Mahmoud’s arrest is a blatant attack on freedom of expression,” it said in a statement. “We demand that he be immediately released and that the authorities immediately drop all charges against him.” The channel added that it was also unclear whether al-Kashif had been charged with any crimes or if there had been a court order to detain him. Sources inside the government told Reuters news agency that Al Jazeera’s editor in chief has been summoned to the Saudi interior ministry, the country’s de facto ruler, for questioning. The sources said that the interrogations related to the broadcast of the Al Jazeera English channel by the channel’s journalists in the country. If the government alleges that Al Jazeera’s journalists are working with a foreign government, which would likely be Qatar, there could be an international outcry and sanctions. It was unclear if al-Kashif had been seen at the ministry since his arrest. {articleGUID} A Reuters journalist saw al-Kashif being taken out of the ministry early on Saturday morning, dressed in his full-length black abaya robe, as a car carrying him drove off. While it is still unclear whether al-Kashif has been charged with any crime, Al Jazeera said he is being held at the Riyadh Ritz-Carlton hotel, the same hotel where the Saudi interior minister is staying. The channel said his trial would be held at a location not yet known. The channel said on Friday that al-Kashif, its head of programmes, was being investigated for “inciting people to attend illegal gatherings”. More than a dozen Saudi dissidents were rounded up and arrested earlier this year, but Al Jazeera said it could not verify whether al-Kash 82157476af
